

Scene – Snow Falling

INT. LATE AT NIGHT.

Play the Lab space as if it is a loft apartment. Play in lover/lover or brother/sister.

LEARN BOTH PARTS and be ready to play either.

A SITS ON A COUCH LOOKING OUT THE WINDOW AT THE FALLING SNOW.

B EMERGES FROM BEDROOM.

B: You going to be there long?

A: It's snowing.

B: Yeah.

BEAT

B: So, as I said before, are you going to be here long?

A: Until the snow stops.

B: That could be a while.

A: Yeah.

B: Something you want to tell me?

BEAT

A: No.

BEAT, THEN SUDDENLY FAST: THE FOLLOWING LINES OVERLAP

A: I didn't mean it, it just happened.

B: I know.

A: So fast, it happened so fast.

B: I know it did.

A: So fuckin' fast.

BEAT

B: Lives change.

A laughs/giggles

B: That's funny?

BEAT OF SILENCE

B: So it's not funny?

A: No it's hilarious, uproarious, riotous, insane ... we're here on a planet spinning in the nothingness of space, alive by some cosmic fluke ... driving cars that are weapons ... and a person puts out a finger ...

B: A little girl, not a person.

A: Yeah. It's morbid, ironic.

B: Less so if you aren't drinking.

A: I'm not drinking.

BEAT – THEN B DECIDES TO WADE IN

B: But you were, weren't you?

BEAT OF SILENCE

B: Weren't you? I'm not a cop. Just tell me.

BEAT OF SILENCE

A: It's stopped snowing.

B: Yeah.

A: So I'm going.

BEAT

B: Don't Please.

A GOES OR STAYS – YOUR CHOICE.
